The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Paustian, Beck, Dickson and Maxwell present. Supervisor Rawson was absent.

Auditor Kerri Tompkins thanked Managers, staff, poll workers, IT, FSS, Sheriff's office, EMA, County Attorney's office and others for all the assistance with the election. She reviewed there were 129,678 registered voters on election day, with a turnout of 90,612 for a total turnout of 69.87%. Early voting was 47% and Election Day was 53% of the turnout. There were a record 14 satellite voting locations, the new E-poll books from Tenex which had great feedback and all four DS450 machines were ran to count the absentee ballots. There were 94 of the SOS citizenship challenges and a total of 52 Provisional Ballots with 19 Provisionals rejected by the absentee Board. In 2016 there was a 67% turnout and in 2020 there was a 71% turnout.

Supervisor Paustian drew for the tie in the Winfield Township Trustee race. Keith Krambeck was the winner.
