The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Bribriesco, Beck, Dickson and Paustian present. Supervisor Maxwell joined online.

Elections Manager James Martin thanked It staff, Sheriff's Deputies and the recount boards for their assistance and a smooth process. He reviewed there was a daily livestream on YouTube for the public to watch the process. There were two recounts held consecutively with a total of 90,611 ballots counted. House 98 decided to let election day numbers stand, while District 1 went with the recount numbers. The decision changes Miller-Meeks who loses one vote, and Bohannon who gains six votes. He also reviewed the DS200 machines used at the precincts are seven years old while the DS450 machines used for the recount are only one year old. The optical scan technology is a higher quality on the new machines. The plan is to replace the DS200 machines before the next presidential election with the better optical scanning technology.

Moved by Bribriesco, seconded by Paustian the recanvass of votes for all county votes cast in the general election on November 5, 2024, for the United States House of Representatives District One. Roll Call: All Ayes.
