Engineer Angie Kersten reviewed authorizing the County Engineer to make necessary road closures and reduced speed limit in work zones during the 2026 calendar year. She reviewed this is an annual item and does not include closures for community events.

Applications Manager Stephanie Macuga reviewed a Jail Management System Software negotiation request. She reviewed the three round process, requirements and reference checks.
