

Scott County Board of Supervisors
January 27, 2026 8:30 a.m.

The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Bribiesco, Dickson, Maxwell, Paustian and Beck present.

Applications Manager Stephanie Macuga reviewed an approval to award the Time and Attendance 10-year software contract to TimeClock Plus, LLC (TCP) with a total estimated cost of \$1,200,000.00. She reviewed the cost per year, and that the year one cost includes new timeclocks for all locations. She also noted the consolidation of scheduling within the timekeeping system and that the attorney's office has reviewed the contract.

Macuga also reviewed an approval to award the IT Service Management (ITSM) professional services contract to Crowe LLP for \$53,800.00. She noted that the current work order system is approximately 15 to 20 years old and does not support managing services, projects, and assets within a single system. The system is also used by Facilities for preventive maintenance and work orders, and a Facilities and Support Services component may be included as part of the contract.

Supervisors also discussed the CIPCO power plant coming back before the Board. Plans are to have presentations at the next Committee of the Whole and a Public Hearing at the next Board meeting.
