The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Dickson, Maxwell, Paustian and Beck present. Supervisor Bribriesco joined online at 8:36 a.m.

Information Technology Director Matt Hirst reviewed the purchase of Novatime Time and Attendance maintenance and support in the amount of \$36,639.00. He reviewed this is the current solution in use with plans for the new software to go live around the first of the year.

Sheriff Tim Lane reviewed the purchase of two (2) Polaris Ranger XP 1000 all-purpose Utility vehicles from Polaris Sales, Inc. for total price of \$46,748.92.
