

Scott County Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Bribiesco, Dickson, Maxwell, Paustian and Beck present. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Bribiesco, seconded by Paustian a motion approving the minutes of the March 24, 2026 Committee of the Whole, the March 26, 2026 Special Board Meeting and the March 26, 2026 Board Meeting. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Moved by Bribiesco, seconded by Paustian that the following seven consent agenda items be approved. Roll Call: All Ayes.

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The purchase of Novatime Time and Attendance maintenance and support in the amount of \$36,639.00 is hereby approved. 2) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (57-2026)

A motion to approve one (1) Class C liquor license renewal for Davenport Country Club, 25500 Valley Drive, Pleasant Valley.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma reported that the County continues to monitor legislation at the state level; he hopes to have more information on the impact of the property tax bill soon. He noted his attendance at a Grow Quad Cities meeting including a catalog of what attracts people to our area and attended a Department Head meeting. He also discussed future funding considerations, including the John Deere Foundation and local schools, for the Coordinated Assessment Program for youth. Sharma reminded staff and Supervisors of the upcoming Heroes and Heavy Equipment event for Scott County employees and elected officials at Secondary Roads. He also noted the upcoming joint meeting with Planning & Zoning and reported that the Risk Manager position has been posted online.

Supervisor Beck reviewed a Waste Commission meeting, the next cell is in process, and they are looking at installing a large litter fence. He also reviewed Ports of Eastern Iowa and the final Assessors meeting.

Supervisor Dickson reviewed meetings attended including Workforce Development and a CIPCO informational hearing. She also reviewed a Rock Island Commuter Passenger Rail Committee kickoff meeting, they are estimating seven to ten years to add the approximately 55 mile route to join at Wyanet, for service to Chicago.

Supervisor Bribriesco reviewed an upcoming meeting with the Seventh Judicial District.

Supervisor Maxwell reviewed a Waste Commission meeting and an Assessors meeting. He also reviewed a Grow Quad Cities meeting that included talk of the different types of transportation in the area.
