

Scott County Board of Supervisors
April 21, 2026 8:31 a.m.

The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Dickson, Maxwell, Paustian, Beck and Bribresco present.

Engineer Angie Kersten reviewed the approval of the plans and specifications for furnishing bridge replacement project on 35th Avenue over a Tributary to Mud Creek in Section 34 of Liberty Township, Project No. L-822—73-82. She reviewed the current structure and noted that the new structure will utilize a precast concrete deck slab, with Secondary Roads staff completing the work. She also discussed replacing the existing timber piling with steel piling.

Facility and Support Services Director Tammy Speidel reviewed a five-year labor only agreement for the Jail and YJRC for a total of \$120,000.00 with Securitas.

Speidel also reviewed a five-year agreement with Thinksafe for inspection of AED equipment in the amount of \$3,741.78. She noted that the replacement of several machines resulted in a new contract, reflecting a savings of approximately 54% compared to the previous agreement.

Speidel also reviewed the awarding of the contract for the Paul Revere Square Treasurer's construction project to Swanson Construction Company in the amount of \$1,994,000.00. She noted that five bids were received, with Swanson Construction Company submitting the lowest bid. She also referenced prior experience working with the contractor and reviewed the additional options requested for approval, including the fire alarm system and the lift.

Speidel also reviewed the purchase of HVAC equipment for the Paul Revere Square Treasurer's project for \$107,288.00.

Speidel also reviewed the purchase of furniture and installation from Paragon Interiors for \$107,133.38. She reviewed the standardization of furniture for ease of use and replacement parts.

Human Resources Generalist Andrea Ahmann reviewed a collective bargaining agreement between Scott County and the Chauffeurs, Teamsters, and Helpers – Local 238.

Sheriff Tim Lane reviewed a Sheriff's office application for a four-year grant, Violence Against Women from the Iowa Attorney General's Office, Crime Victim Assistance Division. He reviewed the funds assist with investigations for stalking, sexual assault, and domestic abuse.

Budget and Administrative Services Director David Farmer reviewed the setting of a Public Hearing for Thursday, May 21, 2026 at 5:00PM during the Board Meeting for an amendment to the county's current FY26 Budget.

Farmer also reviewed the Notice of Public Hearing on Adopting the Fiscal Year 2027 County Budget, Secondary Roads Annual Budget and 5-year construction program. Public Hearing to be held Thursday, April 23, 2026 at 5:00PM during the Board Meeting in the 1st Floor Boardroom in the Administrative Center.
