

Scott County Board of Supervisors
June 4, 2026 5:00 p.m.

The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Beck, Dickson, Maxwell, and Paustian present. Bribiesco joined online. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Dickson a motion approving the minutes of the May 19, 2026 Committee of the Whole and the May 21, 2026 Board Meeting. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Upon review of the agenda Supervisor Bribiesco asked to remove consent agenda items #6, #7, #9, and #10 to vote separately.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Dickson that the following sixteen (16) consent agenda items be approved. Roll Call: All Ayes.

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT) contracted with Cramer and Associates to perform bridge and roadway repairs at the U.S. Highway 61 and 210th Street interchange, and Scott County participated in the contract to complete additional Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patching on portions of 210th Street under County jurisdiction. 2) On March 26, 2026, the Scott County Board of Supervisors approved participation in the Iowa DOT contract with a total project expenditure not to exceed \$325,000 for PCC pavement patching. 3) During construction, additional pavement patching was completed beyond the originally anticipated quantities, including preliminary patch locations that remained marked for removal and additional full-width lane patching required for traffic control and construction efficiency purposes. 4) The final contract quantities resulted in an additional project cost of \$24,239 above the previously approved authorization amount. 5) The Scott County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the additional expenditure of \$24,239 for the PCC pavement patching project on 210th Street. 6) This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage. (103-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) That the three-year contract in the total amount of \$53,020.33 with the Schneider Company for hosting and implementation of the Beacon Web GIS hosting solution is hereby approved. 2) That the contract represents hosting and implementation fees of \$18,184.00 for fiscal year 2027, \$16,993.33 for fiscal year 2028, and \$17,843.00 for fiscal year 2029. 3) That the IT Director is hereby authorized to sign said agreement. 4) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (106-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The 2023 property taxes due in September 2024 and March 2025 and the 2024 property taxes due in September 2025 and March 2026 for Leonard Hayes, 3112 W. Locust Street, Davenport, Iowa in the amount of \$3,433.00 including interest and fees are hereby suspended. 2) The County Treasurer is hereby directed to suspend the collection of the above stated taxes and utility fees thereby establishing a lien on said property as required by law with future collection to include statutory interest, if any. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (107-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The second half of the 2024 property taxes for Kayla Shaffnit, 3101 Greenbrier Dr, Bettendorf, Iowa, in the amount of \$1,461.00 including interest and fees are hereby suspended. 2) The County Treasurer is hereby requested to suspend the collection of the above stated taxes thereby establishing a lien on said property as required by law with future collection to include statutory interest, if any. This resolution shall take effect immediately. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (108-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The 2025 special assessments receipt numbers 287852, 293945, 294970, 300592 and the 2024 property taxes due in September 2025 and March 2026 for Angelic Smith, 4228 Warren Street, Davenport, Iowa, in the amount of \$955.67 and \$3,367.00 including interest and fees are hereby suspended. 2) The County Treasurer is hereby directed to suspend the collection of the above stated taxes thereby establishing a lien on said property as required by law with future collection to include statutory interest, if any. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (109-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) Iowa Administrative Code 641, Chapter 132 requires each EMS service program to have a Medical Director. The code defines a Medical Director as “a physician designated by the service program and responsible for providing medical direction and overall supervision of the medical aspects of the service program”. This agreement covers Dr. Vermeer's roles and responsibilities as the Medical Director for MEDIC EMS of Scott County. 2) This agreement covers Dr. Vermeer's roles and responsibilities as Chair of the Physician's Advisory Board. 3) That the chairman is hereby authorized to sign said agreement. 4) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (110-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) This Agreement is to establish an agreement with Durant Ambulance Service, Inc. that will support the EMS system within Scott County by providing at a minimum of Basic Life Support (BLS) or Paramedic Advanced Life Support (ALS) (as staffing allows) ground transport and ground transfer services in areas of Northwest Scott County when Durant Ambulance offers quicker response times. 2) Durant Ambulance agrees to provide mutual aid services to MEDIC EMS of Scott County upon request and according to the terms specified in the Mutual Aid agreement between the two entities. 3) This Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2026, and be in effect for one (1) year. 4) The County agrees to pay Durant Ambulance, the sum of \$20,000.00 payable in four installments. 5) That the Board of Supervisors Chairman is hereby authorized to sign said agreement on behalf of the Board. 6) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (111-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) That the Board approves the security agreement with Eastern Iowa Community College for two (2) years. 2) That the Chair is approved to sign such agreement, once the agreement is approved and received from EICC. 3) This resolution shall take effect July 1, 2026. (112-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) Iowa Code Section 445.63 states When taxes are owing against a parcel owned or claimed by the state or a political subdivision of this state and the

taxes were owing before the parcel was acquired by the state or a political subdivision of this state, the county treasurer shall give notice to the appropriate governing body which shall pay the amount of the taxes due. If the governing body fails to immediately pay the taxes due, the board of supervisors shall abate all of the taxes. 2) City of Le Claire has requested the abatement of the following parcels:

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The Scott County Board of Supervisors approves for payment all warrants numbered 347654 through 347922 as submitted and prepared for payment by the County Auditor, in the total amount of \$1,357,107.93. 2) The Board of Supervisors approves for payment to Wells Fargo Bank all purchase card program transactions as submitted to the County Auditor for review in the amount of \$171,118.36. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (114-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) That the 28E Intergovernmental Agreement between Scott County, Iowa, and the City of Davenport, Iowa, for the E. 90th Street Pavement Reconstruction Project No. 35061/PRJ-4432 be approved. 2) That the project includes reconstruction of approximately 0.42 miles of E. 90th Street (210th Street) from Harrison Street (165th Avenue) to Holden Drive into a three-lane Portland cement concrete roadway with paved shoulders. 3) That E. 90th Street (210th Street) is a joint jurisdiction roadway between Scott County and the City of Davenport and pursuant to the

agreement, the City of Davenport shall serve as the contracting authority for the project and provide engineering design, bidding, and construction administrative services.4) That Scott County shall be responsible for fifty percent (50%) of the actual construction costs associated with the project. 5) That the Chairperson is hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of Scott County. 6) That this resolution shall take effect immediately.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Dickson that the following resolution (102-2026) be approved. Roll Call: Four Ayes with Bribiesco voting Nay.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED: 1) by the Board to accept the bid from Valley Construction Co., in the amount of \$2,975,715.39 and awards the associated contract(s) to the same; 2) that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of the Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law; and 3) by the Board of Supervisors of Scott County, Iowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor's bond and certificate of insurance, Angela K. Kersten, the County Engineer for Scott County, Iowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contract(s) in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this county.

2) That purchase quantities and supplier selection shall be based on the lowest hauled, in-place cost as determined by county operational needs, material availability, and hauling efficiency. 3) That the County Engineer is hereby authorized to purchase road rock and ice control sand materials as necessary to support roadway maintenance and winter operations during FY2027. 4) This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Dickson that the following resolution (105-2026) be approved. Roll Call: Four Ayes with Bribiesco voting Nay.

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) That Scott County participates in the Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT) statewide contract for the purchase of snow and ice control salt for FY2027. 2) That the bid submitted by Compass Minerals America, Inc., for the furnishing of snow and ice control salt at a unit price of \$125.19 per ton is hereby accepted. 3) That the County Engineer is hereby authorized to purchase snow and ice control salt through the Iowa DOT statewide contract as needed for winter maintenance operations during FY2027. 4) That the County Engineer is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents and administer the purchase in accordance with the Iowa DOT statewide contract requirements. 5) This resolution shall take effect immediately.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma spoke on the ending of current legislation that included an electronic binder provided by our County Coalition emailed to the board. Sharma reviewed the intergovernmental and Bi State Regional Commission. He reviewed he will be a panelist for Quad City Health Initiative. Sharma reviewed the upcoming Quad City Board Meeting, Davenport City of the State Address, and Department Head Meeting. He spoke and offered condolences on the passing and loss of Bridget Hillyer of Secondary Roads.

Supervisor Paustian spoke on attending the Metropolitan Planning Transportation Policy Committee. He reviewed a study by Iowa DOT on intersection of Highway 61 and Coonhunters Road. Paustian reviewed the EMA meeting and upcoming Region Nine Transportation Meeting at Secondary Roads.

Supervisor Bribiesco extended her sincerest condolences to Bridget Hillyer's family and Scott County.

Supervisor Beck spoke on behalf of the board offering condolences to Bridget Hillyer's tragedy. Beck reviewed Bi-State Meeting, Rock Island Memorial Service, and RIADA

meetings. Beck reviewed the upcoming RDA, JMC's command change, Davenport State of The City, Waste Commission, and Eastern Iowa Ports meetings.

Supervisor Dickson followed with her sentiments and condolences for Bridget Hillyer.

Chairman Maxwell spoke on the SECC meeting. Maxwell reviewed the hiring of three (3) new employees. He reviewed the Bi-State and Visit Quad Cities meetings. Maxwell reviewed the upcoming meetings including the Canvass of the Votes on June 9th, Davenport's State of the City on June 11th, and Tentative Special Board Meeting on June 12. Mahesh Sharma reviewed this is scheduled as a placeholder if there is a request for a recount.

Moved by Paustian, seconded by Bribriesco at 5:22 p.m. a motion to adjourn. All Ayes.
