

Scott County Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Paustian, Dickson, and Maxwell present. Beck and Bribiesco were absent.

Auditor Kerri Tompkins spoke on the absence of Election Manager James Martin due to an emergency medical issue. Tompkins expressed her sincere thank you to her staff who also attended the meeting. Tompkins congratulated the performance and teamwork of those in her office during the election. Chairman Maxwell suggested each member of the Auditor's office speak their name and years of service.

Auditor Kerri Tompkins reviewed Seventeen thousand nine hundred forty-two (17,942) people voted at the polls on election day. Tompkins reviewed Two thousand one hundred six-teen (2,116) absentee ballots were accepted for counting. Tompkins reviewed Zero provisional ballots were accepted for counting. She reviewed a total of 20,058 people voted. Tompkins reviewed that with the primary, people don't win but move forward with the nomination for the November elections and will be on the November ballots.

Auditor Tompkins reviewed there was no nomination made by a political party for the following offices of the June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026 Primary Election. She reviewed the County Board of Supervisors has two (2) open positions for the Democratic party and one (1) for County Attorney of the Democratic party. She reviewed she will send that information to the parties.

Chairman John Maxwell asked what percent of turnout it was.

Auditor Tompkins reviewed the reports will be posted later today.

Elections Specialist Bryan Nash reviewed approximately fifteen (15) percent.

Chairman Maxwell reviewed the approximate turnout percentage and asked how this differed to last year.

Auditor Tompkins reviewed about fourteen (14) percent the previous year. She reviewed across the state with early voting that numbers were reporting lower. She expressed her interest when the numbers finalize.

Chairman Maxwell asked about the lower percentage even with the Governor's race.

Auditor Tompkins answered yes and reviewed that numbers were lower with absentee voting.
